



Terms & Conditions



These guidelines will be reviewed regularly and amended where necessary in accordance with the advice provided by Public Health England, Government and British Gymnastics.



Payment

• Class bookings are on a monthly rolling basis. Fees are due monthly on the 2nd of the month and are based on the number of training Mondays in that month (2,3 or 4 weeks). This will reserve your place for that month. We do ask for a months notice of cancellation.



PreSchool (45 minutes) : £8 per class

Year R Recreational (45 minutes): £10 per class

Years 1 - 6 Recreational (1 hour): £12 per class



Terrific Tumble (1½ hours): £15 per class

Terrific Tramp (1 hour): £12 per class



Key Points

• All staff, gymnasts and parents should be aware of the main COVID-19 symptoms which include a high temperature, a new, continuous cough or a loss or change to the sense of smell or taste.

• If staff, gymnasts, parents or members of their household experience any symptoms we ask them not to visit AGC and to inform us immediately.

• We will continue to follow advice given by Public Health England, Government and British Gymnastics and will follow Government guidelines for 'Test and Trace'.

• As part of our on-going commitment to general health and hygiene we are only providing essential staff on-site. As a result there is no admin support on-site - all classes must be booked and paid for prior to attendance. Contact phone numbers are displayed on the Front Door, in Reception and the Cloakroom.

• Non-attendance of a class will not generally be eligible for a refund - we have reserved your place and staff and facility costs are still the same. If you miss a class due to a requirement to isolate due to COVID we will credit you with the missed classes on receipt of a positive test result. Children no longer have to isolate after a close contact so we will not provide credit unless a positive test result is received.

• Classes are provided in line with the Hampshire school term time-table. Extra holiday classes may also be offered on an ad-hoc basis.



Upon Arrival

- Gymnasts should arrive ready to train (tee-shirt/shorts, long hair secured) and bring a named water bottle (water fountains are unavailable). Coats/shoes etc must be left in the Cloakroom, water bottles are taken into the gym and placed in individual pigeon-holes.
- Please wait for the start of the class in Reception / Cloakroom areas.
- Gymnasts who require inhalers, epi-pens or other medical items should bring them in a clearly named plastic bag- there will be an easily accessible area to store these in during their class.
- Gymnasts will enter and sanitise hands before moving to training zone.
- Late arrivals will not be admitted (after the register has been taken) as it is very disruptive to the class.
- Please note that the corridor with the Track Run-Up is part of the gym, not a public area.
- Due to the size and layout of our facility we are unable to provide parental viewing stations in the gym itself. We do provide a TV live-feed in the cloakroom.

Cleaning

- A cleaner will be on-site throughout our services for general cleaning of all toilets, touch-points etc. in addition to the daily cleaning.
- A confirmed COVID infection may mean we have to close classes at short notice to allow for deep-cleaning. Please ensure your contact details are up to-date.

Equipment

- We have refurbished the open Foam pits - they are now Semi-Slung pits with cleanable vinyl covers.
- All non-cleanable equipment and mats have been removed from use.

PreSchool Specific

- Our PreSchool gymnasts attend with an adult - additional adults may be accommodated with prior approval.
- The accompanying adult will take an active part in the training.
- We allow a younger sibling (baby) to attend as long as you accept they cannot join in with the activities.

Recreational Specific

- During Class

- Gymnasts will store their water bottle in individual class cubbyholes.
- Each class will have a dedicated training zone - one week on Floor, one week on Tracks, one week on Pit Tramps.

- In the event of an accident where first aid is required, the First Aider may wear PPE (a face mask, face shield, gloves, apron etc) and sanitise their hands before treatment. They will also wash and sanitise their hands after treatment.
- We encourage children to go to the toilet before they arrive at the gym, should a gymnast need to use the bathroom hands must be washed thoroughly after using the toilet, then sanitised. Child friendly posters are used to remind gymnasts.
- Posters are also used to remind gymnasts of Catch It, Bin it etc.
- Unfortunately any form of disruptive behaviour will be dealt with immediately (1st instance - verbal correction, 2nd - Cooling off sit-out period, 3rd - Removal from class). Our coaches are there to aid skill development and behaviour disruptive to the class will not be accepted.

- Upon Exit

- Gymnasts must ensure they remove all belongings from the cubbyholes before leaving the gym. Parents should be vigilant of this rule as we no longer keep lost property. Anything left at the end of the day will be disposed of.
- Parents must wait in Reception / Cloakroom to collect their children.

Gymnasts Code of Conduct

Respect all club staff, coaches and fellow gymnasts. Be polite and courteous at all times. As a representative of Andover Gymnastics Club you must display professional and respectful conduct at all times. Rudeness, insulting, threatening or racist behaviour, shouting, swearing, exclusion, physical or mental abuse will not be tolerated.

Parent Code of Conduct

Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their chosen sport. Never punish or belittle your child for poor performance or making mistakes. Use correct and appropriate language at all times. Publicly accept any official judgements, we discourage challenging or arguing with club coaches and other staff. Endeavour to establish good communications with the club, coaches and officials for the benefit of all. Your child is your responsibility prior to the start of a class. Please do not leave them before their class begins. Always collect your child promptly at the end of the session, along with all their belongings.
